AN ACT concerning

**Annual Curative Bill**

FOR the purpose of generally curing previous Acts of the General Assembly with possible title or other defects; altering the conditions on residential property that constitute public nuisances in Charles County; ratifying the repeal of a certain section of the Annotated Code; providing for the effect and construction of certain provisions of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally repealing and reenacting with or without amendments certain Acts of the General Assembly that may be subject to possible title or other defects in order to validate those Acts.
