(II) COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY THE TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE CORRECTIONAL TRAINING COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
