[(iii)] 3. known as the Ocean City Amusement and Fishing Pier; and

[(5)] (V) property that is owned by the Ocean City, Maryland Chamber of Commerce.

(2) THE GOVERNING BODY OF WORCESTER COUNTY MAY PROVIDE, BY LAW, FOR:

(I) THE AMOUNT AND DURATION OF A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(II) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

(b) (1) The governing body of Worcester County or the governing body of a municipal corporation in Worcester County may grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on property that is owned by the Pocomoke City Chamber of Commerce.

(2) The governing body of Worcester County or of a municipal corporation in Worcester County may provide, by law, for:

(i) the amount and duration of a property tax credit under this subsection; and

(ii) any other provision necessary to carry out this subsection.

[(c) The governing body of Worcester County may provide, by law, for:

(1) the amount and duration of a property tax credit under this section; and

(2) any other provision necessary to carry out this section.]

(a) (2) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county may impose, by law, the recordation tax uniformly on all instruments of writing that secure repayment of debt created by the sale of bonds authorized under [Title 14, Subtitle 1 of] Article 41, TITLE 14, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE CODE.
