appropriate court for a determination that the property is the property of the claimant and for an order that it be returned.

(3) A conviction, plea of guilty or of nolo contendere, or probation under the provisions of [Article 27, § 641 of the Code] § 6-220 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE is prima facie evidence that the property is contraband.

(e) (3) After application of the proceeds and deposit in accordance with paragraph (2) of this subsection, any remaining balance shall be paid to the buyer, unless the sale occurred because of the seizure of the goods by a police department, bureau, or force, in which event the remaining balance shall be paid to the police department, bureau, or force that seized the goods, to be disposed of in accordance with the provisions of [§ 297 of Article 27 of the Code] TITLE 12 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE or any other law that applies to the seizure and forfeiture of the goods.
