Except as otherwise provided, a court may order a juvenile who is charged with the commission of a delinquent act or a criminal defendant who has not been convicted of a crime of violence to perform community service and assign the juvenile or defendant to a particular work project:

## (2) as a condition of:

- (i) probation, whether granted under [Article 27, § 641 or § 641A of the Code] § 6-220 OR § 6-225 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE or otherwise; 11-802.
- (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the managing official of a local correctional facility may designate correctional officers employed by the local correctional facility to have the power to make arrests as authorized by [Article 27, \$594B(r)\$ of the Code] 2-207(D) OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.
- (b) Correctional officers designated by a managing official to make arrests as authorized under [Article 27, § 594B(r) of the Code] § 2-207(D) OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE shall meet the minimum qualifications and satisfactorily complete the training required by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

(a) (10) "Law enforcement officer" means a law enforcement officer as defined in Article 27,  $\S$  727(b) of the Code or any federal law enforcement officer who exercises the powers set forth in [Article 27,  $\S$  594B(h) of the Code]  $\S$  2–104 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.

- (e) The court does not have jurisdiction over:
- (1) A child at least 14 years old alleged to have done an act which, if committed by an adult, would be a crime punishable by death or life imprisonment, as well as all other charges against the child arising out of the same incident, unless an order removing the proceeding to the court has been filed under [Article 27, § 594A of the Code] § 4-202 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE;
- (4) A child at least 16 years old alleged to have committed any of the following crimes, as well as all other charges against the child arising out of the same incident, unless an order removing the proceeding to the court has been filed under [Article 27, § 594A of the Code] § 4–202 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE:
  - (i) Abduction;
  - (ii) Kidnapping;
  - (iii) Second degree murder;
