- (a) (1) The Board consists of 7 members.
 - (2) Of the 7 Board members:
- (i) 3 shall be master heating, ventilation, air-conditioning, and refrigeration contractors licensed in the State, a subdivision of the State, or another state provided that state has licensing requirements equivalent to the licensing requirements of this title;
 - (ii) 1 shall be a master electrician;
 - (iii) 1 shall be a master plumber; and
 - (iv) 2 shall be consumer members.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint the members of the Board with the advice of the Secretary and with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (b) Except for the initial members of the Board, of the members appointed under subsection (a)(2)(i), (ii), and (iii) of this section:
- (1) 1 shall be from the area that consists of Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties;
- (2) 1 shall be from the area that consists of BALTIMORE CITY, AND Baltimore, Cecil, and Harford Counties;
- (3) 1 shall be from the area that consists of Anne Arundel, Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's Counties;
- $\ \,$ (4) $\ \,$ 1 shall be from the area that consists of Howard, Montgomery, and Prince George's Counties; and
- (5) 1 shall be from the area that consists of Allegany, Carroll, Frederick, Garrett, and Washington Counties.

- (a) (1) In this section, "officer" includes a superintendent, manager, or agent of a corporation regardless of whether the corporation provides heating, ventilation, air—conditioning, or refrigeration services.
- (2) Any person, including an officer, who violates § 9A-501, § 9A-502, § 9A-503, or § 9A-504 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$50 for each day or part of each day that the violation continues] \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH AND, ON A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR BOTH.
- (b) Any person who knowingly and willfully violates any provision of § 9A-402 of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or both.
