

(2) when the grievance decision involves a dental service, a licensed dentist, or a panel of appropriate health care service reviewers with at least one dentist on the panel who is a licensed ~~dentist~~ DENTIST, who shall consult with a dentist who is board certified or eligible in the same specialty as the service under review; or

(3) when the grievance decision involves a mental health or substance abuse [service,] SERVICE:

(I) a licensed[physician, or] PHYSICIAN WHO:

1. IS BOARD CERTIFIED OR ELIGIBLE IN THE SAME SPECIALTY AS THE TREATMENT UNDER REVIEW; OR

2. IS ACTIVELY PRACTICING OR HAS DEMONSTRATED EXPERTISE IN THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE OR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE OR TREATMENT UNDER REVIEW; OR

(II) a panel of other appropriate health care service reviewers with at least one physician, selected by the private review agent who:

[(i)] 1. is board certified or eligible in the same specialty as the treatment under review; or

[(ii)] 2. is actively practicing or has demonstrated expertise in the [alcohol, drug abuse,] SUBSTANCE ABUSE or mental health service or treatment under review.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2002.

CHAPTER 54

(House Bill 189)

AN ACT concerning

Aquaculture Operations - ~~Transgenic Marine Animals~~ and Genetically Altered Species

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Natural Resources from issuing a permit for the raising of certain transgenic species or genetically altered species except under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the raising of certain transgenic species and genetically altered species in aquaculture operations.
