[(iii)] (IV) Shall apportion among the approved projects the limit imposed under paragraph (3) of this subsection on the sum of contributions eligible for tax credits for the fiscal year.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Board of Supervisors of Elections and Orphans' Court Judges - Compensation
