members of the Board of Supervisors of Elections or the judges of the Orphans' Court for Garrett County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 60

(House Bill 231)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Juvenile Justice - Appointment of Deputy Secretary

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Juvenile Justice to appoint a certain number of Deputy Secretaries to assist with the duties provided by law or designated by the Secretary; and generally relating to the appointment of personnel at the Department of Juvenile Justice.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C - Juvenile Justice

2-103.

- (a) With the approval of the Governor, the Secretary may appoint [1] TWO OR MORE Deputy [Secretary] SECRETARIES as necessary.
- (b) (1) The Deputy [Secretary serves] SECRETARIES SERVE at the pleasure of the Secretary.
- (2) The Deputy [Secretary is] SECRETARIES ARE entitled to the salary provided in the State budget.
- (3) The Deputy [Secretary has] SECRETARIES HAVE the duties provided by law or delegated by the Secretary.
- (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE A DEPUTY SECRETARY TO BE THE ACTING SECRETARY WHEN THE SECRETARY IS ABSENT FROM THE STATE OR OTHERWISE UNAVAILABLE.
