

(7) DISAGREEMENTS BETWEEN A PARENT AND A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF A FREE APPROPRIATE PUBLIC EDUCATION AND THE QUESTION OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ARE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (C) THROUGH (H) OF THIS SECTION AND COMAR 13A.05.01.15C.

CHAPTER 62

(House Bill 262)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Board of Community College Trustees

FOR the purpose of changing the maximum number of consecutive terms a person may serve as a member of the Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County; and generally relating to the Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education

Section 16-407

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

16-407.

(a) The Board of Community College Trustees for Frederick County consists of seven members. Of the members:

(1) Each shall be a resident of Frederick County; and

(2) Each shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of 5 years.

(b) (1) A member of the Board of Community College Trustees may not serve more than [two] THREE consecutive 5 year terms.

(2) A member of the Frederick County Board of Education may not serve on the Board of Community College Trustees.
