

(3) One member of the board of county commissioners or county council shall be a member of the board, ex officio, as chosen by the board of county commissioners or county council from time to time.

(4) (i) Except as provided in [subparagraph] SUBPARAGRAPHS (ii) AND (III) of this paragraph, as the terms of the initial appointees expire or as vacancies occur, their successors shall be elected by a majority vote or quorum of the board for terms of three years or the remainder thereof; and hereafter, these positions shall be so filled.

(ii) In St. Mary's County, as the terms of the initial appointees expire or as vacancies occur, their successors shall be appointed by the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County for a term of 3 years if a term expires, or the rest of the term if a term is vacated.

(III) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, AS THE TERMS OF THE INITIAL APPOINTEES EXPIRE OR AS VACANCIES OCCUR, THEIR SUCCESSORS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY FOR A TERM OF 3 YEARS IF A TERM EXPIRES, OR THE REST OF THE TERM IF A TERM IS VACATED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 64

(House Bill 278)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Westchester Community Center Loan of 1999

FOR the purpose of removing the requirement in Chapter 230 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1999, Baltimore County - Westchester Community Center Loan of 1999, that the grantee grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Baltimore County - Westchester Community Center Loan of 1999.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
