- 2. \$42,000 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2003;
- 3. \$43,000 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2004;
- 4. \$44,000 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2005; AND
- 5. \$45,000 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006 AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT CALENDAR YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of Charles County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of Charles County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

(House Bill 349)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages - Public Golf Courses

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-502.

(a) This section applies only in Charles County.
