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## CHAPTER 72

### (House Bill 370)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Wine Festival License**

FOR the purpose of creating in Garrett County a wine festival alcoholic beverages license; providing for the terms and conditions of the license; authorizing direct sale of alcoholic beverages from a wholesaler or producer to a wine festival licensee under certain circumstances; specifying certain conditions for the date of the festival; requiring the wine festival licensee to have a certain alcoholic beverages license; authorizing a wine festival licensee to hold another alcoholic beverages license of a different class or nature; authorizing the Garrett County Board of License Commissioners to establish certain fees, approve a festival date and location, and adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE GARRETT COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN GARRETT COUNTY.

(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE ANNUALLY ONE WINE FESTIVAL LICENSE.

(D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, AN APPLICANT FOR A WINE FESTIVAL LICENSE SHALL BE A HOLDER, WITHIN THE COUNTY, OF AN EXISTING RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, STATE CLASS 3 WINERY LICENSE, OR STATE CLASS 4 LIMITED WINERY LICENSE.

(E) A WINE FESTIVAL LICENSEE SHALL:
