Article 5 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 - Calvert County

[2-104.

The county commissioners shall hold a public meeting at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County every Tuesday beginning at 10 a.m., except that on the second Tuesday of every month they shall also hold an evening meeting beginning at 8 p.m. If that day is a holiday, the meeting shall be held at the nearest convenient time, which shall be determined by the commissioners.]

2-104.

(A) THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL MEET REGULARLY FOR THE TRANSACTION OF COUNTY BUSINESS ON THE DAYS THE BOARD SETS BY RESOLUTION AT A PUBLIC PLACE DESIGNATED FOR THE MEETINGS.

(B) THE RESOLUTION SETTING THE REGULAR MEETING DAYS OF THE BOARD MAY PROVIDE FOR:

(1) THE HOLDING OF MEETINGS IN ADDITION TO THE REGULAR MEETING; AND

(2) THE CANCELLATION OF MEETINGS BECAUSE OF ILLNESS, VACATION, OR OTHER REASONABLE CAUSE.

(C) THE COUNTY BUSINESS MEETINGS CONDUCTED BY THE BOARD SHALL COMPLY WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT UNDER ARTICLE 25, § 5 OF THE CODE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
