

CHAPTER 84**(House Bill 575)**

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class D Licenses

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Liquor Control Board for Harford County to issue certain Class D alcoholic beverages licenses to holders of Class B alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County; establishing certain annual license fees; authorizing holders of Class B licenses to apply for a Class D license authorized by this Act; authorizing the Liquor Control Board to decide the number of Class D licenses to be issued; requiring the Liquor Control Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

6-401.

[(n) (1) This section does not apply in Harford County.]

(N) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY.

(2) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD MAY ISSUE ONLY TO THE CURRENT HOLDER OF ANY CLASS B LICENSE:

(I) A 7-DAY (ON-SALE) CLASS D LICENSE FOR ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, WITH AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF \$3,000; OR

(II) A 7-DAY (ON- AND OFF-SALE) CLASS D LICENSE FOR ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, WITH AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF \$4,000.
