

(9) IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, SHOWS, SALES, EXHIBITIONS, OR FAIRS CONDUCTED WITHIN THE CENTRAL PEDESTRIAN AREAS OF NONENCLOSED SHOPPING CENTERS, PROVIDED THAT THE EVENT COMPLIES WITH ALL APPLICABLE CODES AND ORDINANCES AND THAT ALL APPLICABLE PERMITS ARE SECURED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

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## CHAPTER 87

(House Bill 596)

AN ACT concerning

### **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Caterer's License**

FOR the purpose of establishing a caterer's license in Frederick County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue a caterer's license to a holder of a certain alcoholic beverages license; establishing a certain annual license fee; specifying the scope of the license; requiring the holder of the license to prepare, deliver, and provide food with alcoholic beverages for consumption at a catered event; requiring the Frederick County Health Department to approve certain facilities before a license may be issued, reissued, or renewed; requiring a holder to provide certain employees, including at least one employee with a certain certification; requiring that alcoholic beverages remain in the possession of the holder after the catered event; allowing a holder to exercise certain privileges under the license only during certain times; specifying that a caterer's license is not needed for certain events under certain circumstances; and generally relating to caterer's licenses in Frederick County.
