AN ACT concerning

Maryland Emergency Management Agency - Report - Statewide Swift Water Flood Rescue Plan

FOR the purpose of requiring the Director of the Maryland Emergency Management Agency ~~to formulate, with certain assistance, and administer a certain statewide swift water flood rescue plan and to coordinate certain educational programs; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to the formulation and administration of a certain swift water rescue plan and the coordination of certain educational programs, with certain assistance, to develop and submit a certain report to the Governor and the General Assembly by a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to developing a statewide swift water flood rescue plan.~~
