SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

12-107.

(b) (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink on the licensed premises of any license holder any alcoholic beverages not purchased from the license holder on said premises and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the premises; and it shall be unlawful for any license holder to permit any person to drink any alcoholic beverage not purchased from the said license holder on the premises covered by the license which he holds and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the premises.

(6) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO SPECIAL LICENSES ISSUED IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY TO ANY BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, VETERANS, HOSPITAL, OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION UNDER § 7-101(R) OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act ~~shall take effect October 1, 2001~~ is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 100

(House Bill 319)

AN ACT concerning

Prohibited Species of Crabs

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations to limit or prohibit the importation, use, catching, or possessing of certain nonnative crab species which have been determined to be harmful to the ecology and natural resources of the State.
