

The grantee has until June 1, [2003] ~~2005~~ 2004, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2003.

CHAPTER 33

(House Bill 168)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Medical Services - Length of Service Award Program

FOR the purpose of providing that certain volunteer fire, rescue, and emergency medical services members shall receive certain length of service award program credits during certain pending workers' compensation claims under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the length of service award program in Calvert County.

Section 14-104

Article 5 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1986 Edition and July 1991 Supplement, as amended)

(As enacted by Chapter 52 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 - Calvert County

14-104.

(a) In order to qualify for any benefits, points shall be credited to each volunteer in accordance with the following:

(1) Five points shall be credited for approved training courses of a duration less than 25 hours. Ten points shall be credited for approved training courses
