

A PERSON WHO, BY VIRTUE OF EMPLOYMENT OR OFFICIAL POSITION, HAS POSSESSION OF OR ACCESS TO INDIVIDUALLY IDENTIFIABLE DNA INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM OR STATEWIDE DNA REPOSITORY MAY NOT WILLFULLY DISCLOSE THE INFORMATION IN ANY MANNER TO A PERSON OR AGENCY NOT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE INFORMATION.

(B) OBTAINING DNA INFORMATION WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT, WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION, WILLFULLY OBTAIN INDIVIDUALLY IDENTIFIABLE DNA INFORMATION FROM THE STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM OR STATEWIDE DNA REPOSITORY.

(C) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

SUBTITLE 6. LOCAL DIVISION.

2-601. LOCAL DIVISION ESTABLISHED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THERE IS A LOCAL DIVISION IN THE DEPARTMENT.

(B) RESOURCES PROVIDED BY DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY HAVE AND PROVIDE THE EMPLOYEES, BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES, AND OTHER OPERATING MATERIALS FOR THE LOCAL DIVISION AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(C) LOCAL DIVISION EMPLOYEES.

THE EMPLOYEES IN THE LOCAL DIVISION ARE IN ADDITION TO THE REGULAR NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN THE DEPARTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 88B, § 63(a), (f), and (g).

In subsection (a) of this section, the former phrase "with the powers, duties, functions, and employees provided in this subtitle" is deleted as unnecessary. The various provisions that relate to the powers, duties, functions, and employees of the Local Division are stated explicitly in this subtitle.
