

**CHAPTER 75**

**(Senate Bill 198)**

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County - County Board of Education and Superintendent of Schools**

FOR the purpose of providing that the procedures for the appointment or reappointment of the Harford County Superintendent of Schools are those that are applicable to all counties in the State; repealing the requirement that the Harford County Board of Education provide public notice that the county board will conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent of schools by a specific date; repealing the requirement that the county board conduct an evaluation of the county superintendent and share the findings of the evaluation with the county superintendent by a certain date; repealing the county superintendent's reappointment notification requirement to the county board; and generally relating to the Harford County Board of Education and the Harford County Superintendent of Schools.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

4-201.

(b) (1) The term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1. A county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(2) [Except in Harford County, by] BY February 1 of the year in which a term ends, the county superintendent shall notify the county board whether the superintendent is a candidate for reappointment.

(3) In the year in which a term begins, the county board shall appoint a county superintendent between February 1 and June 30. However, if the county board decides to reappoint the incumbent superintendent, the county board shall take final action at a public meeting no later than March 1 of that year.

(4) If a county board is unable to appoint a county superintendent by July 1 of a year in which a term begins, the provisions of subsection (d) of this section apply.

[(5) (i) This paragraph applies only to Harford County.
