SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Election Law

4-203.

- (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2)(ii) of this subsection, in Baltimore County, members of the party central committees may not run at large.
  - (2) The Republican Party Central Committee shall consist of:
- (i) four members elected from each councilmanic district in the county; and
  - (ii) a chairman elected from the county at large.
- (3) [The] FOR THE Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee [shall consist of five members elected from each councilmanic district in Baltimore County]:
- (I) TWENTY-FIVE MEMBERS, FIVE FROM EACH DISTRICT, SHALL BE ELECTED FROM LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS 6, 8, 10, 11, AND 42, EACH DISTRICT BEING LOCATED WHOLLY WITHIN BALTIMORE COUNTY:
