(D) HEARING BOARD.

"HEARING BOARD" MEANS A BOARD THAT IS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF TO HOLD A HEARING ON A COMPLAINT AGAINST A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

(E) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

(1) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

(I) IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO MAKE ARRESTS; AND

(II) IS A MEMBER OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES:

1. THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE;

2. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY;

3. THE BALTIMORE CITY SCHOOL POLICE FORCE;

4. THE BALTIMORE CITY WATERSHED POLICE FORCE;

5. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, BUREAU, OR FORCE OF A COUNTY;

6. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, BUREAU, OR FORCE OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION;

7. THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF OF A COUNTY;

8. THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, BUREAU, OR FORCE OF A BICOUNTY AGENCY;

9. THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY POLICE;

10. THE POLICE FORCES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION;

11. THE POLICE FORCES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES;
