

- ~~and~~ (1) qualify for assistance from the fund during fiscal year 2002 or 2003;
- (2) apply for assistance from the fund before July 1, 2003; and
- (3) remain eligible for assistance at the time services are provided.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial performance audit of the electric universal service program under § 7-512.1(c)(3) of the Public Utility Companies Article, as enacted by this Act, shall be completed on or before January 7, 2004.

SECTION ~~4~~ 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections ~~1 and 2~~ 1, 2, and 4 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2003.

SECTION ~~5~~ 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section ~~4~~ 5 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 30, 2003.

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Parole Commission - Membership

FOR the purpose of increasing the number of appointed members of the Maryland Parole Commission; and generally relating to the membership of the Maryland Parole Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Correctional Services

7-202.

- (a) (1) The Commission consists of [~~eight~~] TEN members.
- (2) With the approval of the Governor and the advice and consent of the Senate, the Secretary shall appoint the members of the Commission.
- (b) Each commissioner shall:
