SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES THAT QUALIFIES AS AN EXEMPT ORGANIZATION UNDER \S 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, AS THE COUNCIL DETERMINES.

(2) THE ASSETS NOT DISPOSED OF SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE COUNCIL IS LOCATED, EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE COUNCIL, OR TO THE INDIVIDUAL COUNTIES.

THE COUNCIL SHALL COOPERATE WITH STATE AND LOCAL DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES THAT HAVE RELEVANT STATUTORY FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES. 1–105.

SUBTITLE 1. MEMBERSHIP

- (A) THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS FROM CECIL, KENT, AND QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTIES:
- (1) NINE COMMISSIONERS, THREE FROM EACH COUNTY, APPOINTED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTY GOVERNING BODIES AS VOTING MEMBERS:
- (2) THREE COUNTY ADMINISTRATORS, ONE FROM EACH COUNTY, AS NONVOTING EX OFFICIO MEMBERS;
- (3) (I) THREE MUNICIPAL ELECTED OFFICIALS, ONE FROM EACH COUNTY, APPOINTED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS AS VOTING MEMBERS; OR
