**CHAPTER 155**

**(House Bill 455)**

AN ACT concerning

**Prince George's County – Board of License Commissioners – Alcoholic  
Beverages Inspectors**

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
