 - (iii) The annual license fee is \$100.
- $% \left(iv\right) \left(iv\right)$ The licensee may store for sale and sell beer and wine to the public.
- (v) The beer and wine shall be consumed on the premises not earlier than 1 hour before and not later than 1 hour after:
 - 1. A regular performance; or
- 2. A special fund-raiser performance exclusively for the benefit of the Cultural Arts Center MARYLAND ENSEMBLE THEATRE.
- (vi) The president and two other officers of Maryland Ensemble Theatre shall sign the application for the license filed on behalf of the [Cultural Arts Center] MARYLAND ENSEMBLE THEATRE.
- (vii) Two of the signatories from Maryland Ensemble Theatre shall be residents of Frederick County.
