SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

1–102.

(a) (1) In this article the following words have the meanings indicated.

(17) “Light wine” means any naturally fermented wine containing not in excess of [14] 15.5 percent of alcohol by volume.

4–101.

(a) In the jurisdictions listed in this section, “light wine” is a fermented beverage that contains not in excess of [14] 15.5 percent of alcohol by volume unless another percentage is listed.
