SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-222

- (a) (1) In Washington County the operators of any amusement park, whether individual, association of individuals, or a corporation, may be entitled to a license for the sale of beer within the confines of its park.
- (2) The fee for such license shall be one hundred dollars (\$100) each calendar year, and shall entitle the holder to sell beer at one or more locations within the park from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on every day from May 1 to September 30 of each year, except Sundays and election days.
- (3) Such licensees shall be subject to all laws, rules and regulations applicable in Washington County to the sale of beer, not inconsistent with the provisions of this section; nothing contained in § 9–102 of this article shall apply to any license issued pursuant to this section.
- (b) (1) A separate license, called a "pouring license" may be issued countywide by the Washington County Liquor Board.
- (2) The holder of a "pouring license" may only sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises.
