SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C - Juvenile Justice

- (a) The Department shall provide for care, diagnosis, training, education, and rehabilitation of children by placing them in group homes and institutions that, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 2-120.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, are operated by any nonprofit or for profit entity.
- (b) (1) The Department shall reimburse these entities for the cost of these services at appropriate monthly rates that the Department determines, as provided in the State budget.
- (2) The reimbursement rate may differ between homes and institutions that provide intermediate services, as defined by the Department, and homes and institutions that provide full services.
- (e) The Department may not place a child in a group home or other residential facility that is not operating in compliance with applicable State licensing laws.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "WILDERNESS PILOT PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM FOR A GROUP HOME IN WHICH THE FACILITY AND ACTIVITIES ARE RELATED TO NATURE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, IN A SITE THAT IS LEFT ESSENTIALLY IN ITS NATURAL STATE, AND WHERE LIVING AND PROGRAM QUARTERS AND ACTIVITIES ARE INTEGRATED INTO THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT.
- (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, SHALL ESTABLISH AT LEAST ONE WILDERNESS PILOT PROGRAM IN THE STATE.
