(e) Except at a licensed stationary blind or blind site, a nonresident may not hunt wild waterfowl from a boat that is anchored unless accompanied by a Maryland resident.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.

- (b) (4) (i) The provisions of this paragraph apply only in Carroll County.
- (iii) A person 18 years old [and] OR older may serve, [and] sell, OR DELIVER alcoholic beverages in restaurants [in connection with the serving and selling of a meal].
