### AN ACT concerning

## **Maryland Election Modernization Fund**

FOR the purpose of establishing a special, continuing, nonlapsing fund for the purpose of upgrading election equipment and related purposes; specifying the sources and uses of the fund; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Election Modernization Fund.

Article – Election Law Section 2–107 Annotated Code of Maryland

(2003 Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article - Election Law

2-107.

- (A) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND ELECTION MODERNIZATION FUND.
- (2) THE FUND IS ESTABLISHED AS A CONTINUING FUND FOR PROGRAMS RELATING TO THE FEDERAL HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT OF 2002 AND RELATED EXPENDITURES.
- (3) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO  $\S$  7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- (4) THE TREASURER SHALL SEPARATELY HOLD AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- (5) THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.
- - (B) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
    - (1) MONEYS APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- (2) MONEYS OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE FUND, WHICH MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT; AND
