3-214. RECERTIFICATION AFTER REVOKED CERTIFICATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IF THE CERTIFICATION OF A POLICE OFFICER IS REVOKED, THE POLICE OFFICER MAY NOT APPLY FOR RECERTIFICATION UNTIL 2 YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REVOCATION ORDER.

(B) AUTHORITY OF COMMISSION TO RECERTIFY.

THE COMMISSION MAY RECERTIFY AN INDIVIDUAL AS A POLICE OFFICER AFTER THE CERTIFICATION OF THE POLICE OFFICER IS REVOKED.

3-215. APPOINTMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS, POLICE SUPERVISORS, AND POLICE ADMINISTRATORS.

(A) DEFINITIONS.

(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "PERMANENT APPOINTMENT" MEANS THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SATISFACTORILY MET THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE COMMISSION AND IS CERTIFIED AS A POLICE OFFICER.

(3) "POLICE ADMINISTRATOR" MEANS A POLICE OFFICER WHO HAS BEEN PROMOTED TO FIRST-LINE ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES UP TO BUT NOT EXCEEDING THE RANK OF CAPTAIN.

(4) "POLICE SUPERVISOR" MEANS A POLICE OFFICER WHO HAS BEEN PROMOTED TO FIRST-LINE SUPERVISORY DUTIES.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS.

AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT BE GIVEN OR ACCEPT A PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT OR PERMANENT APPOINTMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER, POLICE
