

programs and campuses under each institutional board's jurisdiction without the approval of the Secretary, as provided in Section 15-105 of the Education Article.

(d) To prescribe procedures and forms for carrying out the above provisions.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in accordance with Section 7-109 of the State Finance and Procurement Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, it is the intention of the General Assembly to include herein a listing of nonclassified flat rate or per diem positions by unit of State government, job classification, the number in each job classification and the amount proposed for each classification. The Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals may make adjustments to positions contained in the Judicial portion of this section (other than judges) that are impacted by changes in salary plans or by salary actions in the executive agencies. The salaries of the Constitutional officers reflect their salaries as of January 2004. The salaries of the Judiciary Clerks of Court A, B, C and D reflect their salaries as of December 2003.
