\$218,000 of the funds in the State Board of Social Work Examiners Fund established under § 19–206 of the Health Occupations Article;

\$3,000,000 of the funds in the Universal Service Trust Fund established under § 3–807 of the State Finance and Procurement Article; and

\$1,692,000 of <u>A total of \$1,692,000 in the aggregate from</u> the funds in the Special Fund established under \$ 11-401 of the Business Regulation Article <u>and the Racing Facility Redevelopment Bond Fund established under \$ 11-206 of the Business Regulation Article</u>.

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, on or before June 30, 2004, the Governor shall transfer to the General Fund:

\$10,000,000 \$11,000,000 of the funds in the Waterway Improvement Fund established under § 8–707 of the Natural Resources Article;

\$3,000,000 of the funds in the Uninsured Division of the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund established under § 20–201 of the Insurance Article;

\$2,000,000 of the funds in the account of the State Use Industries established under § 3–507 of the Correctional Services Article;

\$500,000 of the funds in the account of the Maryland Affordable Housing Trust established under Article 83B, § 11-102 of the Code;

\$393,100 \$243,100 \$393,100 of the funds in the Special Fund established under \$ 11–401 of the Business Regulation Article;

\$150,000 of the funds in the Special Fund established under § 11 401 of the Business Regulation Article, contingent on the failure of House Bill 1149.;

\$1,602,311 \$1,361,156 of the funds in the Vehicle Theft Prevention Fund established under Article 88B, § 74 of the Code; and

Any balance remaining in the account of the Maryland Higher Education Supplemental Loan Authority.

SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in fiscal year 2004, if the amount of State lettery proceeds paid to the General Fund in fiscal year 2003 is less than \$441,991,000, then the Governor may transfer from the unclaimed prize fund established in § 9-122 of the State Government Article to the General Fund the lesser of:

- (a) The difference between the amount of State lottery proceeds paid to the General Fund in fiscal year 2003 and \$441,991,000; or
 - (b) \$10,000,000.
