(IV) (V) A FERRY COMPANY THAT IS GRANTED A FRANCHISE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH MAY NOT CONDUCT ANY GAMBLING OR GAMING ACTIVITIES ~~PROHIBITED UNDER THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE~~ ON ANY FERRY THAT IT OPERATES UNDER THE FRANCHISE.

AN ACT concerning

Education - High School Diplomas - World War II and Korean Conflict Veterans

~~FOR the purpose of allowing an honorably discharged veteran of World War II to apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private school in the individual's junior or senior year in certain circumstances; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to high school diplomas for World War II veterans.~~

FOR the purpose of allowing a certain individual honorably discharged from military service to apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private high school under certain circumstances; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to high school diplomas for certain veterans.
