- (b) (1) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
 - (i) a renewal application form; and
 - (ii) a notice that states:
 - 1. the date on which the current license expires;
- 2. the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
 - 3. the amount of the [renewal] LICENSE fee.
- (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
- (2) pays to the Board a [renewal] LICENSE fee [of \$20] SET BY THE BOARD; and

- (a) The Board shall reinstate the license of an individual who, for any reason, has failed to renew the license if the individual:
- (1) applies to the Board for reinstatement within 2 years after the license expires;
- (2) meets the renewal requirements of § 14-314 of this subtitle [and pays to the Board all past due renewal fees]; and
- (3) except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, pays to the Board a reinstatement fee [of \$100, in addition to all past due renewal fees] SET BY THE BOARD.
- (b) (2) The Board may reinstate a license under paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection only if the individual:
- (i) meets the renewal requirements of § 14-314 of this subtitle [and pays to the Board all past due renewal fees];
- (ii) if required by the Board, states reasons why reinstatement should be granted; and
- (iii) except as otherwise provided in subsection (c) of this section, pays to the Board a reinstatement fee [of \$100, in addition to all past due renewal fees] SET BY THE BOARD.
