- (2) pays to the Board:
- (I) THE NONREFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD UNDER \S 15–306 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (II) the license fee [required] SET BY THE BOARD [under § 15-312(a)(2)(i) of this subtitle]; and 15-312.
- (a) If an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:
- (2) the Board will issue a license to the applicant, on receipt of a license fee [of:
 - (i) \$60 for a license to practice land surveying; and
- $$({\rm ii})$$ \$20 for a license to practice property line surveying] SET BY THE BOARD.
- (b) On payment of the [appropriate] license fee, the Board shall issue a license to each applicant who meets the requirements of this subtitle.
- (d) Subject to any regulation that the Board adopts, it shall replace any lost, mutilated, or destroyed license certificate on:
 - (1) request of the licensee; and
- (2) payment of the replacement fee set by the Board[, not exceeding \$35].

- (b) (1) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
 - (i) a renewal application form; and
 - (ii) a notice that states:
 - 1. the date on which the current license expires;
- 2. the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
 - 3. the amount of the [renewal] LICENSE fee.
- (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
 - (2) pays to the Board a [renewal] LICENSE fee [of:
 - (i) \$60 for a license to practice land surveying; or
