SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-210.

(a) Except for a person employed to operate a vessel for a master fishing guide under § 4–701(o) OR A PERSON PERMITTED TO OPERATE A CHARTER BOAT UNDER § 4–210.2, any person who desires to accept direct or indirect consideration for providing services as a fishing guide shall obtain a license.

4-210.2.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PERMIT" MEANS A MARYLAND PROVISIONAL CHESAPEAKE BAY CHARTER BOAT PERMIT.
- (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A MARYLAND PROVISIONAL CHESAPEAKE BAY CHARTER BOAT PERMIT.
 - (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A PERMIT IF THE PERSON:
- (1) IS LICENSED BY VIRGINIA OR THE POTOMAC RIVER FISHERIES COMMISSION TO OPERATE A CHARTER BOAT IN THEIR ITS JURISDICTIONAL TIDAL WATERS; AND
- (2) PROVIDES THE DEPARTMENT WITH DOCUMENTATION OF FISHING ACTIVITY FOR 2001 AND 2002 BASED UPON LICENSING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE VIRGINIA MARINE RESOURCES COMMISSION OR THE POTOMAC RIVER FISHERIES COMMISSION.
 - (D) A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT:
- (1) IS VALID ONLY FOR AN AUTHORIZED PERSON OPERATING A VESSEL FOR CHARTER FISHING TRIPS ORIGINATING FROM THE TIDAL WATERS OF VIRGINIA OR THE POTOMAC RIVER; AND
