- (i) (2) "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise:
 - (vi) A {retired} volunteer dentist's license to practice dentistry; and
- (vii) A {retired} volunteer dental hygienist's license to practice dental hygiene;

(VIII) A VOLUNTEER DENTIST'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY;

<u>AND</u>

- (j) (2) "Licensed dental hygienist" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, a holder of:
 - (ii) A teacher's license to practice dental hygiene; [or]
- (iii) A $\{retired\}$ volunteer dental hygienist's license to practice dental hygiene; \overline{OR}
- (IV) <u>A VOLUNTEER DENTAL HYGIENIST'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE</u> DENTAL HYGIENE.
- (k) (2) "Licensed dentist" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, a holder of:
 - (iii) A teacher's license to practice dentistry; [or]
 - (iv) A {retired} volunteer dentist's license to practice dentistry; OR
 - $\underline{(V)}$ A VOLUNTEER DENTIST'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY.

4-302.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, to qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
 - (b) The applicant shall be of good moral character.
- (c) To qualify for a license to practice dentistry, the applicant shall be at least 18 years old.
- (d) To qualify for a license to practice dentistry, the applicant shall hold a Degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery, Doctor of Dental Medicine, or the equivalent, from a college or university that is:
- (1) Authorized by any state or any province of Canada to grant the degree; and
