- (a) (1) A petition alleging that a child is a CINA shall be filed in the county where:
 - [(1)] (I) The child is residing when the petition is filed; or
 - [(2)] (II) The act on which the petition is based allegedly occurred.
- (2) A <u>VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT</u> PETITION REQUESTING A <u>VOLUNTARY DISPOSITION HEARING</u> SHALL BE FILED IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN RESIDES.

3 - 807.

- (a) (4) (i) In Prince George's County, the judges of the circuit court may not appoint or continue the appointment of masters for juvenile causes, except for the purpose of conducting:
- 1. Probable cause hearings, detention hearings, arraignments, acceptances of admissions, and restitution hearings in delinquency cases under Subtitle 8A of this title; [and]
- 2. Shelter care, adjudicatory, and disposition hearings in CINA cases under this subtitle; AND
- 3. VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT DISPOSITION HEARINGS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

3 - 810.

(b) (1) In any proceeding in which a child is alleged to be in need of assistance OR IN ANY VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT DISPOSITION HEARING, the court may exclude the general public from a hearing and admit only those persons having a direct interest in the proceeding and their representatives.

3-811.

- (a) (1) A <u>CINA</u> petition under this subtitle shall allege that a child is in need of assistance OR REQUIRES A VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT DISPOSITION HEARING and shall set forth in clear and simple language the facts supporting that allegation.
- (2) A VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT PETITION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL ALLEGE THAT CONTINUATION OF A VOLUNTARY PLACEMENT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CHILD AND SHALL SET FORTH IN CLEAR AND SIMPLE LANGUAGE THE FACTS SUPPORTING THAT ALLEGATION.

3-817.

(a) After a CINA petition is filed under this subtitle, the court shall hold an adjudicatory hearing.
