- (a) (1) The Board shall consist of [15] 21 members appointed by the Governor WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
 - (2) Of the [15] 21 members:
- (i) [10] 11 shall be practicing licensed physicians, AT LEAST ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE A DOCTOR OF OSTEOPATHY, appointed [from a list submitted by the Faculty] BY THE GOVERNOR AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) SUBSECTIONS (D) AND (E) OF THIS SECTION;
- (ii) 1 shall be a practicing licensed physician appointed at the Governor's discretion;
- (IV) 1 SHALL BE A PRACTICING LICENSED PHYSICIAN WHO PRACTICES COMPLEMENTARY AND ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF CARE APPOINTED AT THE GOVERNOR'S DISCRETION WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY CERTIFIED PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT APPOINTED AT THE GOVERNOR'S DISCRETION AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (F) AND (G) OF THIS SECTION;
- (V) 1 SHALL BE A PRACTICING LICENSED PHYSICIAN <u>WITH A FULL-TIME FACULTY APPOINTMENT</u> APPOINTED TO SERVE AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF AN ACADEMIC MEDICAL INSTITUTION IN THIS STATE APPOINTED FROM A LIST CONTAINING:
- 1. 3 NAMES SUBMITTED BY THE JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE; AND
- $2. \hspace{0.5cm} 3$ NAMES SUBMITTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE;
- [(iv)] (VI) [2] 5 shall be consumer members appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate; and
- [(v)] (VII) 1 shall be a [consumer] PUBLIC member knowledgeable in risk management or quality assurance matters appointed from a list submitted by the Maryland Hospital Association.
