(iii) A payment made in violation of this paragraph shall be forfeited to the State.

f(e)**f**(F) This section does not prohibit an individual from contracting for services to:

- (1) determine the individual's innocence;
- (2) obtain a pardon; or
- (3) obtain the individual's release from confinement.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any application for a grant by the Board of Public Works filed before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION $\underline{2}$. $\underline{3}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.
