the Board of County Commissioners of Somerset County that began on the first Tuesday in December 2002, and is eligible to be reappointed as clerk after the next election of the Board in November 2006.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2003.
