AN ACT concerning

Department of Aging - Continuing Care Retirement Communities - Regulation

FOR the purpose of ~~limiting the definition of a governing body of a continuing care provider to certain providers; expanding the time period in which~~ authorizing the Department of Aging may to consider certain agreements entered into by certain continuing care providers persons when determining whether a certain sales requirement has been met under certain circumstances; providing that if certain ~~continuing care providers~~ persons demonstrate by a certain date that certain development and investment has been completed for ~~expanding a continuing care facility, the remaining portion of the project may not be considered new development~~ a certain facility, the Department may issue a certain certificate if the applicant provides certain assurances; and generally relating to continuing care retirement communities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
