AN ACT concerning

Housing - Community Legacy Program - Neighborhood Intervention Projects

FOR the purpose of altering the purposes of a community legacy project to include the financing of a neighborhood intervention project for the rehabilitation or demolition of properties located in stable neighborhoods under certain circumstances; establishing a certain priority for the review and approval of applications for financial assistance under the Community Legacy Program under certain circumstances; limiting the amount of financial assistance that may be awarded under a community legacy agreement for a neighborhood
