SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development 4-801.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Application" means an application to the Board that may include one or more of the following:
