- (B) FOR PURCHASES OR CONTRACTS INVOLVING LESS THAN \$250,000 WHERE THE COUNTY IS ACTING AS THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR, THE PURCHASE OR CONTRACT MAY BE AWARDED AFTER THE COUNTY OBTAINS QUOTES FOR THE PURCHASE OR CONTRACT FROM AT LEAST 3 VENDORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS.
