- (d) A person may not commit any misrepresentation in applying for an identification card issued under this section.
- (e) A person may not commit any fraud in using an identification card issued under this section.
- (f) A person may not make any misrepresentation in using an identification card issued under this section.
 - (g) (1) An identification card shall be:
 - (i) Of the size and design that the Administration requires; and
 - (ii) Tamperproof, to the extent possible.
 - (2) The card shall contain:
 - (i) The name and address of the applicant;
 - (ii) The birth date of the applicant;
 - (iii) The sex of the applicant;
 - (iv) A description of the applicant;
- (v) A color photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that the Administration requires;
 - (vi) The expiration date of the identification card;
 - (vii) The signature of the applicant; and
 - (viii) The signature and seal of the issuing agent.
- (h) An identification card may be used as legal identification of the individual to whom it is issued for any purpose.
- (i) (1) An identification card ISSUED TO AN APPLICANT AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD expires every 5 years.
- (2) AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED TO AN APPLICANT UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS EXPIRES EVERY 2 YEARS.
- (3) [It] AN IDENTIFICATION CARD may be renewed on application and payment of the fee required by this section.
- (j) ON ISSUING AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO AN APPLICANT UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
- (1) INFORM THE APPLICANT'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE SAFEKIDS PIX PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER § 12–205 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (2) REQUEST THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO INCLUDE THE APPLICANT IN THE DATABASE MAINTAINED BY THE SAFEKIDS PIX PROCRAM.
