

PROGRAM IS LOCATED, THE COURT MAY ISSUE A WRIT OF SUMMONS TO ORDER THE PARTIES TO APPEAR AND TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS AT A CONCILIATION CONFERENCE.

(2) IF A PARTY FAILS TO APPEAR OR FAILS TO PRODUCE THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PILOT PROGRAM MAY APPLY, UPON AFFIDAVIT, TO THE COURT FOR A BODY ATTACHMENT.

(3) IF A PARTY FAILS OR REFUSES TO OBEY A COURT ORDER TO APPEAR OR PRODUCE THE DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AT A CONCILIATION CONFERENCE, THE COURT MAY ISSUE A BODY ATTACHMENT OR COMPEL COMPLIANCE IN ANY OTHER MANNER AVAILABLE TO THE COURT TO ENFORCE ITS ORDER.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "CONCILIATION CONFERENCE" MEANS A CONFERENCE CONDUCTED AT A DEMONSTRATION SITE TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PARTIES TO RESOLVE ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH AN ACTION TO MODIFY OR ENFORCE A DUTY OF SUPPORT PRIOR TO GOING TO A COURT PROCEEDING.

(3) "DEMONSTRATION SITE" MEANS ANY JURISDICTION THAT COMPETES AGAINST PRIVATIZED JURISDICTIONS IN PROVIDING CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT SERVICES.

(B) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL ESTABLISH CHILD SUPPORT DEMONSTRATION SITES IN ALL JURISDICTIONS THAT ARE NOT PRIVATIZED JURISDICTIONS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPETING AGAINST A PRIVATIZED JURISDICTION AS ESTABLISHED IN § 10-119.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH AT LEAST:

(I) FOUR DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2003, AS FOLLOWS:

1. ONE IN CALVERT COUNTY;
2. ONE IN HOWARD COUNTY;
3. ONE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY; AND
4. ONE IN WASHINGTON COUNTY;

(II) SEVEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2005;

(III) ELEVEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2006;

(IV) SIXTEEN DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2007; AND

(V) TWENTY-TWO DEMONSTRATION SITES BY JULY 1, 2008.
